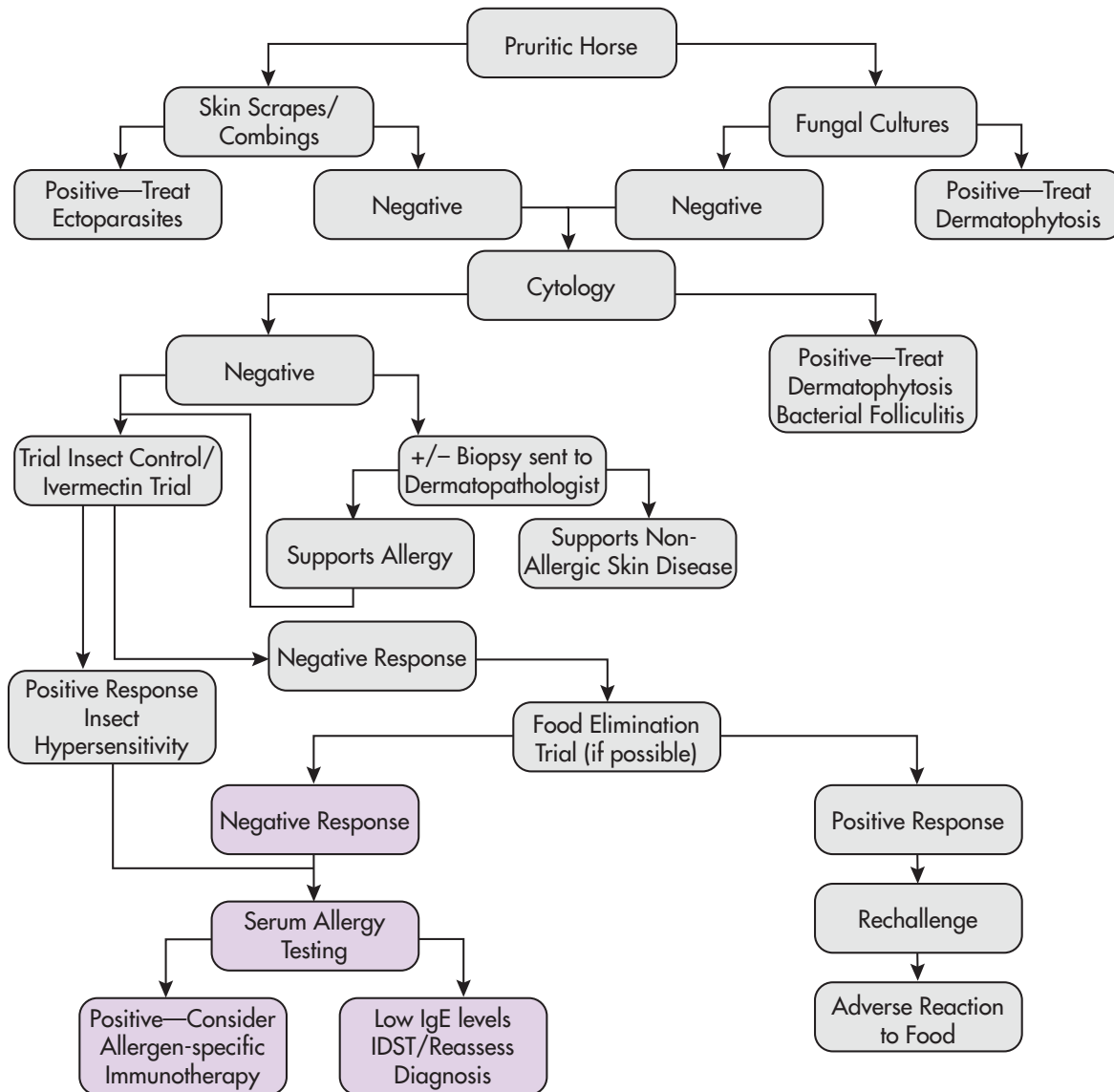


Differential Diagnosis of the Pruritic Horse

Equine allergy may present in a number of ways including generalized pruritus or atopic dermatitis, urticaria, and possibly COPD. A systematic approach is recommended in the diagnostic workup of the pruritic horse. The decision to perform IgE testing is based on a number of factors including: the horse's clinical presentation, history, physical exam, distribution of lesions and response to treatment.
